#### COMMUNITY CENTER SOUND IMPROVEMENT OPTIONS

#### Option 1 – Carpet

Price: \$7,250 - \$10,900

#### Pros:

- Will improve sound.
- Looks nice.
- If tile carpet, can easily replace bad spots.

#### Cons:

- Expensive.
- May not completely solve sound problems.
- Requires more maintenance.
- Requires replacement over time.

#### Option 2 - Sound Deadening Tiles (Wall)

Price: \$1,100-2,500

#### Pros:

- Will improve sound.
- Less expensive than carpet.
- Easy to install.
- Easy to send back if ordered from Amazon and doesn't solve problem.
- No maintenance or replacement required.

#### Cons:

- Can be done in an aesthetically pleasing manner, but not attractive.
- May not completely solve sound problems.

#### Option 3 – Sound Deadening Tiles (Ceiling)

Price: \$1,100-2,500

#### Pros:

- Will improve sound.
- Less expensive than carpet.
- Easy to send back if ordered from Amazon and doesn't solve problem.
- No maintenance or replacement required.
- Might be less noticeable than wall tile.

#### Cons:

- Less effective than wall tiles.
- May not completely solve sound problems.
- Not overly attractive.

#### Hi Tom,

Here are 3 different quotes for carpeting. Prices do include prevailing wage.

A few notes from my meeting with Abbey Carpet:

- 1. The two cheaper two have an approximately 5-7 year life depending on use.
- 2. The more expensive one has an approximately 25+ life span. Interestingly, this one was installed in the Alaskan airport in Fairbanks or Anchorage in 1976 and is still in use.
- 3. Carpet Tiles are cheaper than rolled carpet.
- 4. We should buy a few extra tiles to replace sections when needed at time of purchase.

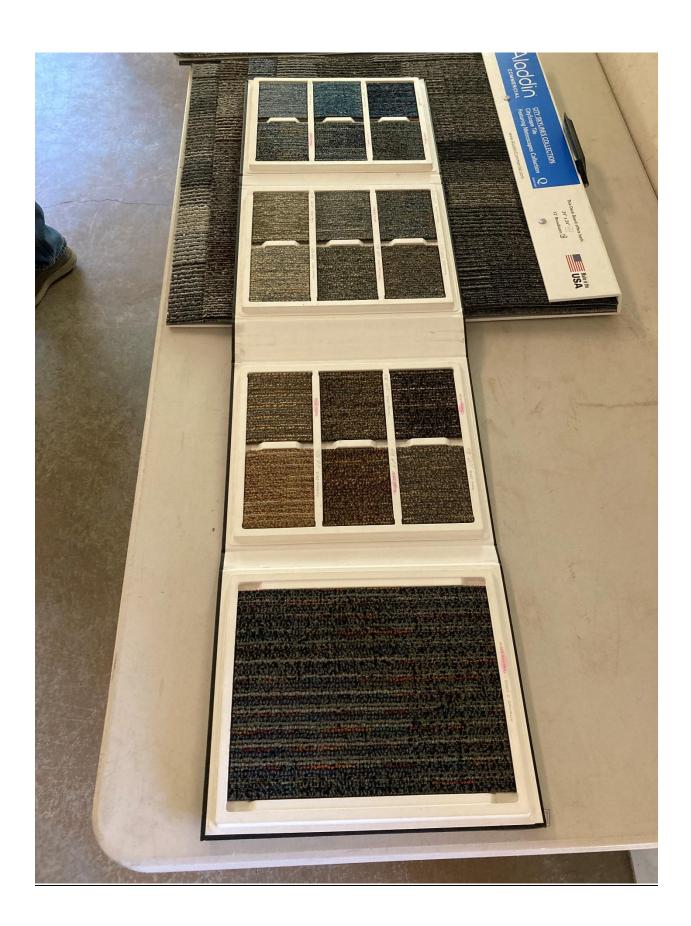

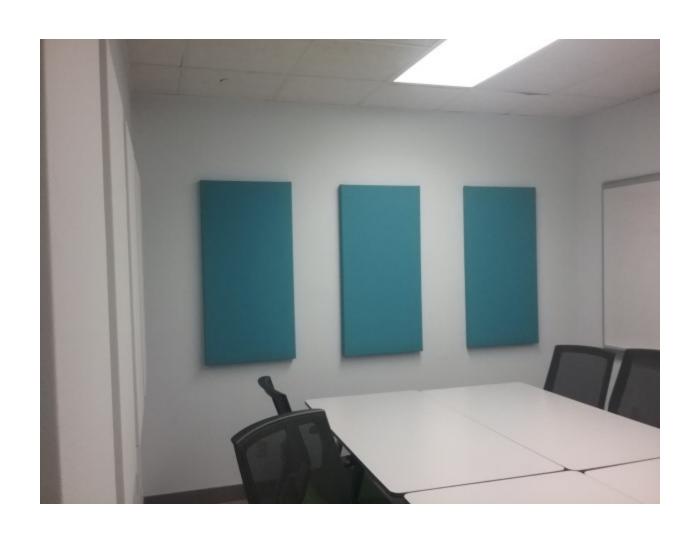
