- A line was replaced on Cedar Dr and we are currently waiting on testing samples before making it fully operational.
- Due to the rock movement next to Twain Harte Lake, the sewer line has been temporarily bypassed.

Fire Committee and Fire Chief Report

- The Fire Committee was canceled.
- Chief McNeal was dispatched to the French Fire on incident management.
- The Twain Harte fire engine and personnel are currently at the Eiler Fire and have been gone almost two weeks.
- The Chief is compiling a plan for unimproved properties to be presented at the next board meeting.

Finance/Admin Committee and Finance Officer Report

- The final resolution regarding the CALPERS contract amendment should be ready by the next board meeting.
- A rate study process will begin in the next few months.

General Manager Report

- The District has received approximately 205 drought measure exception applications
- The Meadow Lane Well project is currently behind schedule, but the water testing samples have been very clean. The next step is a 72 hour pump test.
- GM Trott and Operations Manager Perry are currently investigating the issues surrounding the sewer line on the rock at the lake. Re-routing possibilities are very expensive.
